ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

1. **Doing ministry/preparing for ministry:** two to four hours a week
2. **Participating in meetings/training:** yearly workshop or upon request

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

Participate in training opportunities yearly, or as presented.

Greet teens before activities.

Help keep order in the activities.

Help supervise teens during trips and special activities.

Ensure that rules and policies are followed. Be familiar with them ahead of time.

Deal with disciplinary problems in a discreet manner. Call parents if necessary. Inform youth pastor of any problems.

Pray for wisdom before every event, activity or trip.
